A taste of New York City's new favorites

Boldface names included Molto Mario Batali, with his first (non-Eataly) NYC restaurant in a decade; a New Delhi import, hailed as one of the "Top 50" in Asia; and a few new spots from chefs that already have some Michelin love. Indian Accent

Manhattan majorly ups its Indian food ante with this New Delhi import, which holds the distinction of being one of San Pellegrino's "50 Best in Asia" and the number-one slot of the "50 Best in India." Inventive and refined, the Midtown spot, within Le Parker Meridien hotel, features two-course, three-course and four-course menus, along with an elaborate chef's tasting.
